

CALL FOR PARTICIPANTS

Women, HIV and Aging Research Study

Fife House in collaboration with community and academic partners is conducting a research study to understand the barriers to support and health care that women aging with HIV/AIDS experience.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

If you are a Woman, Living with HIV and 50 years or older and you live in Greater Toronto Area (GTA includes Toronto, Durham, Peel, Halton and York) we want to hear from you.

INTERVIEW DETAILS

Each participant will be asked to take part in a one-on-one interview of 60 to 90 minutes duration at a mutually convenient location. The interview will consist of questions related to barriers to services and resources, issues of discrimination, and changing roles and responsibilities of women aging with HIV/AIDS.

CONFIDENTIALITY

Participation in this research study is strictly voluntary. All initial contacts are confidential and secure. Each participant's name will be replaced by an ID number and all identifying information will be removed from the study in order to protect each participant's confidentiality.

COMPENSATION

Participants will receive \$30.00 cash at the end of their interview, to reimburse them for any expense incurred in order to participate in this study. Consent or refusal to take part in this study will not affect any current or future services provided by Fife House or any partner or collaborating agency.
