Survey: Organizations

- 10 community organizations
- 90% of community agencies bar people

Survey: Community Members

- 5 org's, 30 community members (barred)

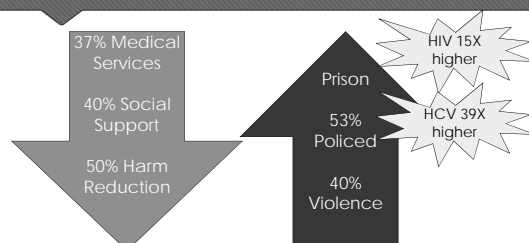
53%

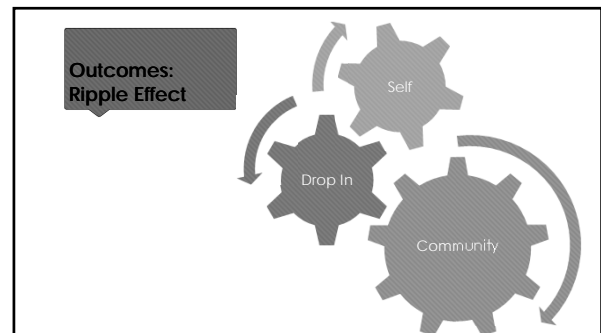


Training
