


Peer Educators, Mentors and Advocates Program

The goal of the PEMAP training program is to provide relevant and comprehensive training to those individuals interested in becoming Volunteer Educators, Mentors and Advocates. This training is targeted towards Persons Living with HIV/AIDS (PHAs), volunteers, families and friends of people infected or affected with HIV/AIDS. Each participant will develop a broad range of knowledge and experience surrounding HIV and its related issues, as well as the facets of education, mentoring, support and advocacy through the training program.



This is a four level (13 weeks) program that provides training and opportunities to enhance skills, attitudes, and knowledge in providing high quality services to People with HIV/AIDS (PHAs).

Training topics include: HIV/AIDS 101, In-house Education, Public Speaking Skills, Cultural Sensitivity and Anti-Oppression Training, Community Education, Peer Mentoring, Treatment updates and Advocacy Skills Training.
