

**Most people who inject
drugs in London are
willing to use supervised
injection services.**



Ontario Integrated Supervised Injection
Services Feasibility Study

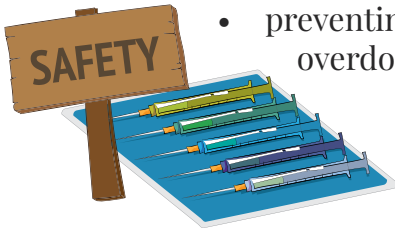
We interviewed 199 people who injected drugs in the last 6 months in London, Ontario to find out about their willingness to use supervised injection services (SIS).

86% of all people who inject drugs — **93%** of men and **76%** of women — reported willingness to use SIS.

91% of people who reported any public injecting were willing to use SIS, compared to **75%** of those who did not.

Most common reasons for wanting to use SIS

- access to sterile injecting equipment
- preventing overdoses



Most common reasons for not wanting to use SIS

- not wanting to be recognized
- fear of being caught by police



Old East (Dundas/Adelaide) and **Downtown** were the top two choices for where to implement SIS in London.
