## **ABOUT US**

The Ontario HIV Treatment Network (OHTN), established in 1998, is a nonprofit organization with a mission to improve the health and lives of people living with and at risk of HIV by using data and evidence to drive change. We work with three main types of partners - 1) testing programs and clinics; 2) AIDS service and other community-based organizations; and 3) policy and system leaders within and beyond the health sector – to support the implementation of the provincial HIV strategy, priorities, and directions.

## **ABOUT THE ROLE**

The Data Engineer reports to the Director, OCS and is responsible for developing and maintaining data warehouse and data storage solutions across OHTN.

This role will support multiple systems, supporting the design of data tables, ETL processes, data element modifications, and database development and management within multiple cloud-based platforms.

The systems include the Ontario Community HIV/AIDS Reporting Tool (OCHART) which captures reporting activities for AIDS Service Organizations, the Ontario Community-Based AIDS Service and Evaluation (OCASE) system, a client records management tool, and the OHTN Cohort Study (OCS), which collects data from over 5,000 people living with HIV at clinical sites across Ontario. This position will support other systems under development as needed.

- ✓ Participate in the design and implementation of the OCHART and OCASE Data Warehouses to support data needs from organizational and ASO data analytics use cases
- ✓ Work with the Data and Biostatistics team to put OCS data tables into production by designing, implementing and integrating end-to-end solutions
- ✓ Support others in the daily use of data systems and ensure adherence to OHTN's Privacy and Confidentiality Policy
- ✓ Maintain tracking of any data or application changes
- ✓ Elicit and understand data requirements and promote modifications or development to enhance data and database structures and foster high quality data standard
